

## Standalone rainwater, Bore Water and Grey Water Systems

## Signage Application 2022 - 2027

## **Terms & Conditions**

To be eligible for a Council issued sign for the use of an alternative water supply; the property must be located within the Tamworth Regional Council area and be connected to a reticulated supply operated by Council.

Each application will be assessed on an individual basis and Council reserves the right to reject applications on a case-by-case basis.

- 1. Council will only issue a sign for standalone rain water tanks, bore water or compliant recycled water systems following an inspection by a Council authorised staff member
- 2. Once a sign has been issued to the resident, it must be displayed whenever the water is in use
- 3. Once a sign has been issued to the resident, the property is subject to unaccounted inspections by Council Compliance officers to ensure the town water supply isn't being used inappropriately
- 4. Signage for rainwater tanks will only be issued if;
  - a) the rainwater tank is a standalone system. Rainwater tanks connected to the treated town water supply are not eligible for a council issued sign; and
  - b) other water storage containers, for example IBC's, are not eligible for a rainwater tank sign; and
  - c) any tank installed to meet BASIX requirements is not a standalone tank and therefore not eligible for a sign.
- 5. Signage for bore water will be issued only if;
  - a) the bore is located on the property requesting the signage and a valid ground water licence must be uploaded when applying for signage
    - WaterNSW regulates all use of bore and therefore Council has no authority at all over its use
- 6. Signage for recycled water systems will be issued for;
  - a) Two kinds of systems only;
    - Greywater diversion: diverts greywater to a pump that distributes this water through plumbed lines 100mm sub surface
    - Greywater treatment: a large, mostly aeration system that treats water to a level where it can be brought above surface again; and
  - b) These systems must be installed by a licensed plumber
  - c) A TRC self-assessment checklist and plumbers declaration must be uploaded when applying for a sign for a *Greywater Diversion Systems*
  - d) A Certificate of Compliance (Section 68 Approval) and plumbers declaration must be uploaded when applying for a sign for *Greywater Treatment Systems*
  - e) No sign will be issued for any other temporary or improvised system

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
