The Nundle District Aboriginal Memorial Group

The Nundle District Aboriginal Memorial will be unveiled on Saturday June 30th from 11am. Members of the public are invited to attend.

The chosen site is near the footpath on Jenkins Street on the Nundle

Courthouse Museum grounds along from the Chinese Gold Diggers Memorial.

The memorial will be opened by Mr Greg Livermoore of the Anaiwan Local Lands Council – Tingha. There will also be other speakers.

Aboriginal people have been part of our district's human habitation since 3000 BC as attested by Dr Mark More, palaeontologist of UNE Armidale.

Our local Aboriginal families in particular have come from the James and Mary Duval family who journeyed south to the Hanging Rock settlement from Ingleba in the 1870s - 150 years ago.
