

YOU CAN NOW REGISTER YOUR ANIMALS ONLINE

The Pet Registry is an online database of microchipped and registered cats and dogs that live in NSW.

Owners are encouraged to create an online profile and claim their existing pets and to register ownership of any new cats and dogs. Online access to the register will give you access to update your contact details, report your pet missing and change the owner of pets.

Breeders are also encouraged to make an online profile. A Breeder ID number will be generated which can be used to easily register litters and transfer the kitten and puppies to their new owners.

What you will need to register

- Be 18 years of age;
- A valid personal email address; and
- Drivers Licence (if you do not have a Drivers Licence you will need other forms of identification for example Medicare Card or Australian Passport).
