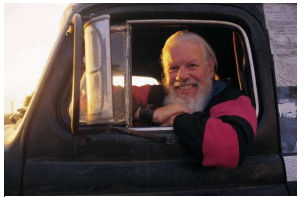

What is a Transit Lounge?

The Home and Community Care plan identified that there was a need to establish a transit lounge for volunteer drivers and clients attending appointments in Tamworth.



Volunteer drivers can travel long distances in our area.

Volunteers are driving for long hours and distances to allow clients to attend

medical appointments due to the centralization of

medical services and reduction of specialist services in outlying areas.

The demand on community transport is increasing with some areas sending cars/buses most days of the week. If more than one client is transported they may need a rest area between appointments.

The Transit Lounge is a free facility which enables drivers and clients to wait in comfort, to have a drink or something to eat, rest or even watch some television for a short period while in Tamworth.

Where is the Transit Lounge?

The Transit Lounge is situated in the Tamworth Community Centre in Darling St, Tamworth. Drivers and HACC clients are welcome to enjoy the comfort of this room. Tamworth Community Centre is a facility of Tamworth Regional Council.

Guidelines for users of the Transit Lounge

- Visitors are asked to report to Reception and sign an Attendance Book on arrival at the Centre. This is necessary for safety reasons. Please make yourself and your clients familiar with emergency procedures in the Centre. (Staff are willing to help with this).
- The Transit Lounge is open between 8.30am and 5pm Monday to Friday.
- Visitors are asked to keep the room clean when using the facility.
- There are tea making facilities, microwave, fridge, sandwich toaster, water cooler, coffee maker, recliner chairs, lunch table and chairs, television and radio for use. The use of the Transit Lounge is free including tea/coffee/biscuits and the use of any equipment.

- Staff are unable to offer personal support for clients who use the Transit Lounge. However they are willing to assist with information for community and local services.
- Please inform staff about any needs for the Lounge, including refilling supplies, anything broken, cleaning or any suggestions that may assist people using the Lounge. This can be done by letting staff know or by writing in the Attendance Book.
- An accessible toilet and shower is next door to the Transit Lounge. Visitors need to bring their own personal supplies.
- Free parking is available at the Community Centre.
- A Public phone is available in the waiting room
