

Terms and Conditions

Please ensure Terms and Conditions are full understood prior to submitting your application. In making an application, I agree to abide by all instructions and conditions imposed by Tamworth Regional Council and acknowledge the following information:

- 1. Coca-Cola Country is open to all country music performers.
- 2. There are five (5) competition categories being: Battle of the Young Stars, Battle of the Bluegrass, Battle of the Bands, Battle of the New Stars and Golden Oldies. There are also two (2) non-competition categories being: Pre-Booked Walk-Ups and Same Day Walk-Ups.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the act to report to the event manager 20 minutes before the elected time of their performance. Event manager contact details and performance times will be provided to successful applicants prior to commencement of Festival.
- 4. All electrical leads and electrical appliances must be tested and tagged.
- 5. Each act must ensure that they do not exceed their performance time allowance. Strict time applies to include your set-up, performance and dismantle from stage.
- 6. With the exception of Battle of the Bands, each artist is allocated 5 minutes for their performance.
- 7. Battle of the Bands entries are allocated 30 minutes on stage which includes set-up, performance and pack down.
- 8. Only one entry per category, per individual.
- 9. Microphones and instrument DI's will be provided by the organisers. Instruments and all other equipment must be supplied by the act.
- 10. No alcohol, illegal substances, bad language, or cigarettes including e-cigarettes will be allowed on or around the stage or within the venue.
- 11. Live music only no pre-recorded or pre-programmed music permitted.
- 12. The act must be available to play at the Grand Final, if selected, on Saturday, 25 January 2020 (Walk Up's not applicable).
- 13. You will only be contacted by the event manager if you are in the grand final.
- 14. The Judges decision will be final and no discussion will be entered into. No critique is given to acts.
- 15. The winning act will receive a cash and subscription prize package.
- 16. All matters relating to the conduct of Coca-Cola Country is totally at the discretion of the organisers.
- 17. Tamworth Regional Council accepts NO responsibility for the security and or any loss or damages incurred to performers or their instruments or equipment during the Tamworth Country Music Festival.
- 18. I hereby consent to Tamworth Regional Council taking photographs and / or audio-visual footage of me and/or my group, for the use in Council publications, promotions, website or other material.
- 19. No damage is to be done to stages, equipment or other property.
- 20. I/we indemnify Tamworth Regional Council and its employees and volunteers against any and all liabilities, claims and actions that may eventuate from performing in the Coca-Cola Country competition during the 2020 Tamworth Country Music Festival, Friday 17 January to Sunday 26 January 2020.
