



How to apply for the fund

Applying is easy!

1. Background research to support works.
2. Determine work to be carried out.
3. Get two quotes from registered trades persons.
4. Fill in an application form.
Download from the Council website or pick one up from Council offices.
(Tamworth, Barraba, Manilla, Nundle)
5. Take a few photos of the proposed areas of work and setting of the building.
6. Owner's consent will be required if the applicant is not the owner.

Note: Some projects may require a development application to be lodged for the proposed works to be undertaken. Council will advise you if this is necessary for your nominated project.

What is the Tamworth Regional Heritage Assistance Fund?

The Tamworth Regional Heritage Assistance Fund was established by Tamworth City Council in 1991 and continued with the formation of the Tamworth Regional Council in 2004.

The fund provides \$ for \$ funding for conservation work to heritage items and properties located within heritage conservation areas as defined by the Tamworth Regional Local Environmental Plan 2010.

Projects funded in the past

Examples of projects which have been funded in the past include:

- Repair and replacement to roof elements
- Painting in heritage colours
- Fencing repair and replacement
- Maintenance or reinstatement of missing items
- Fencing repair and replacement
- Verandah repair and replacement
- Reinstatement of decorative detail
- Certain structural work
- Studies and reports

How much funding is provided?

Priority will be given to work undertaken on a heritage listed property or property within a heritage conservation area. However, projects that do not fall within these criteria are encouraged to apply.

Funding is provided as follows:

- Up to \$3000 for work to properties which are heritage items.
- Up to \$1000 for work to properties which are located within heritage conservation areas.



What you need to do

- Decide on works to be undertaken.
- Contact Council's Heritage Advisor to discuss project details.
- This is a free Council service to assist in making your application.

Projects ineligible for funding

Funding will **NOT** be provided for the following projects:

- Works that have already been completed.
- New additions to a heritage building.
- Work on a government owned building still used for a government purpose.
- Where assistance is reasonably available from another source.
- The purchase of a building, site or moveable structure.
- Where substantial assistance has been previously provided or where the applicant has yet to complete other assisted projects.
- Relocation of a heritage building or work on a relocated building.
