

How do I make a responsible donation to a store?

1. ONLY make donations to stores when they are OPEN.
PLEASE do not leave items when stores are closed!
2. Some stores have dedicated areas or bins to receive donations only when they are open, so please follow their directions provided on signage and check with staff if collection bins are full or you have a large amount to donate.
3. If you have large items or furniture, please check with the store that they can accept those items before trying to donate them as some stores can't take large furniture items.
4. If you have electrical items to donate, please check with the store that they can accept them as some shops can't sell those items and you may be best to take them to a store that can take electrical items.
5. Baby related items, please check with the store as these are very specific items and have specific guidelines around them as well and some stores can't accept them.
6. Please donate clothes that are NOT stained, ripped, broken zips or buttons as these items cannot be repaired.
7. Ask yourself, would you buy this item or give to a really good friend?
If the answer is no, then please don't donate it.
8. PLEASE don't dump your rubbish or items that can't be sold, on the store to deal with. This is not fair to the volunteers to have to deal with or sort through the rubbish.

Can I become a volunteer for my favourite store?

Volunteers are always welcome and you should contact the store directly to discuss becoming a volunteer!
