#### **Booking Officer's Report:**

#### **General Business/ Business Without Notice:**

- The Dungowan Progress Committee have put in an application for funds to upgrade the facilities at the Dungowan Football Ground. J. Gidley-Baird has drawn their attention to the need to upgrade facilities, particularly the amenities because of the campers who use the grounds during Country Music which is a fund raiser for The Dungowan Hall.
- ➤ J. Gidley-Baird suggested the Committee coordinate a document to welcome new people to the community. Eg. Hall Committee, Football club, RFS, Churches, Tennis club, Dungowan PS, Dungowan/Ogunbil Garden Club. The document to be distributed with a mail drop, FaceBook, email, and/or given to new people when they move in.
- ➤ Dungowan PS is holding a Christmas Community get together at the BBQ, play area at the school. To be held on Sunday December 5<sup>th</sup>. The hall could be used if it is wet.
- > This BBQ and play area at the Dungowan PS is now available for community use during school holidays.
- ➤ D. Brown knows of a couple doing voluntary work who may be available to assist with jobs, such as cleaning and removing items stored at the hall but no longer needed. The couple will need to complete a COVID cleaning course authorized by the TRC. D. Brown will follow this up
- ➤ There will be a working Bee on Sunday November 28<sup>th</sup> commencing at 10.am to assess which items need to be removed from the back of the stage area.
- Strategic Plan 2021 2026: tabled by A. Leckie. It was agreed this will be a very useful document.
