IN Council improvement fund

Out To Council explaining benefits that upgrading tennis club kitchen is to the community.

General Business:

HALL AND PAVERS Council inquired if help was needed to remove graffiti in toilets . All done. Council will attend and deal with the sharp rocks. A little more hall painting done, stage floor not finished , and now contractor has pulled out.

SPORTS GROUND Toilet roof still not repaired. An assessment needs to be made on how much Progress contributed to the removal and installing the new fence on the sports ground. Quite a lot of value with labour, and machinery volunteers provided. Will try to install the small gate for oval before gymkhana, but not crucial. Some sight wire will be placed on some of the fence at a cost of around \$300.

GYMKHANA St John has committed to gymkhana, requesting a donation of \$300. Craigs have been contacted. Ribbons have been ordered. Wrist bands will be ordered after choosing the most suitable. Mandy made suggestion that there be a lucky entry gate prize. All agreed. Some of the purchases before the gymkhana will be a new broom, a new urn, a power cord, and the long hose washer needs to be checked where it is. The raffle is going. Application to sponsors will be going out in the next week.

IMPROVEMENT FUND It was decided that we would apply for tables and chairs, and we will need to contribute half of the fund. Lachie is willing to manufacture them, so the cost of material, and the cost of labour needs to be assessed, and then apply for the fund.

TENNIS SHED Some quotes were given for putting a kitchen in the tennis shed . Tamworth Council informed us of a government fund available. The application, with the quotes was put in. There was also explanation on much of the community use of the area of oval, and tennis area. There still is the possibility of Council installing wheel chair access.
