Recreation Ground BBQ- The battery is at the BBQ, gas is supplied by ? key to the gas bottle cage is with George. Cleaning. **Lisa** to be followed up to request the people who clean the toilets to clean the BBQ

Tennis Courts: Following points discussed:

Community concern of water pooling – George reported that the first court to be resurfaced at cost to TRC. Currently being followed up

Court access discussed as per following points:

- a. If there is competition tennis event TRC would not cover the insurance. Tennis Australia would need to be approached for insurance cover.
- b. Social tennis insurance is covered by TRC
- c. Committee to determine any fee and conditions for access. Yet to be confirmed
- d. Signage needs to be followed up.
- e. Decision of where to locate the key to the tennis courts is yet to be determined
