- Reminded staff that Netball competition starts tonight
- Asked if Netball could use plastic orange bollards to put Covid sign in codes on, around the facility
- Asked if TRC check outdoor CCTV footage, to see if teams are utilising lighting on outdoor courts when they haven't booked. Sally said this isn't a part of the current process, but is something that could be organized between the Sports Dome and Netball. As an intermediate, Sally will provide TNA with outdoor bookings so they know who is utilising courts when they shouldn't be
- Spoke about once the blue outdoor courts are resurfaced, Netball and Blake could work together and look at grant funding to resurface black outdoor courts
- Gave an update that the Covid plan has been sent to Sports Dome staff

Sue

- Enquired that some netball clubs aren't getting confirmations for their bookings. Sally explained that if they book the day of or day before, that they may not receive a confirmation in time. Sally would follow up
- Asked if outdoor courts can be high pressure cleaned now that water restrictions have eased?
- Asked when they can expect outdoor netball courts to be resurfaced?
- Gave an update on men's netball competition. This will take place for over two separate weeks after the Thursday night women's winter competition.
- Had noticed that the padded box that sits underneath the fire hose box has gone missing. Sally is confident that one of the new staff members have moved it when cleaning the courts

- Explained that a number of netball posts on the outdoor courts had loose concrete bases and these were making the posts unstable. This was raised by netball a number of ops meetings ago. Sally gave the update that the post on Court 8 will be fixed by this Saturday's competition. The other posts (4-5 in total), will be systematically fixed over time. This process has been decided on, as doing all posts at once will close the outdoor courts for a period of time which is not ideal when these courts are still being used. Sally will give an update to Netball when first post is fixed
