1. Cricket - Vets

- a) Suggest the new nets at Riverside 1 be named. Each lane named after a local national representative
- b) Tamworth Cricket has finalised three name suggestions for the end at No. 1 Oval.
Cricket reminded this sign is at their cost.
- c) Reiterated their thanks for the good playing wicket / surface when the English team toured.

1a) Sport Development Officer to discuss with Sports and Recreation Manager.

1b) Tamworth cricket to decide on one name and detail to Council in a letter why the end at No. 1 Oval should be named after this person.

2. Cricket – Juniors

- a) Queried if each club were sent individual invoices.
- b) Queried an update on the R2 T20 2020 Legacy fund grant. Aware that Vinnie submitted the application however he no longer works for Cricket NSW.

4. Grounds & Facilities Supervisor

- a) Tom complimented the efforts of Kevin Attard and other volunteers in moving the covers to Belmore.
 - b) Detailed Riverside fields 1 and 2 will be used for sports training (namely soccer). These sports fields will not be on the cricket wicket. This usage is a result of the drought and some fields unsuitable for use due to no access to ground water.
 - c) Adam detailed they are doing all they can for the finals this Friday night however are at the hands of the weather. At this stage unless the rain completely stops and the sun dries the wicket it is unlikely the finals will go ahead. Cricket will be notified as soon as possible.
 - d) Disappointed the Baggy Blues game went ahead. This match should have been called off. As a result the wicket was extremely damaged.
 - e) The Baggy Blues match was not booked. Cricket is acutely aware of the process for booking fields.
 - f) TRC did not received a fee waiver request for the Baggy Blues match
